- e. Pierce County Roads: Speed Bumps
 - a. Rick Beloit reached out to Pierce County road department and they said it is the responsibility of the HOA; the County entered our neighborhood on a list of interested neighborhoods for an asphalt company but it will likley be too costly. Re: Speed Limit signs- we can only post 25MPH signs as that is the approved Count speed limit for unincorporated Pierce County
